REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Request For Extension* respectfully states:

1. On October 26, 2022, in the Commission’s *Order Giving Notice of Case Filing, Directing an Answer, And Directing a Staff Investigation*, the Commission ordered Staff to file a report no later than December 16, 2022.

2. On December 8, 2022, included within the Commission’s *Order Denying Motion to Dismiss*, the Commission reordered Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire (“Spire”) to file its *Answer* to the complaint no later than December 19, 2022, which calendared Spire’s *Answer* later than the priority date of the Staff report. Although Staff has already issued preliminary Data Requests (“DRs”) to Spire without the testament of Spire’s *Answer* in this case, Spire’s *Answer* may generate additional DRs.

3. While awaiting Spire’s *Answer*, Staff has drafted and issued supplementary DRs to both Spire and Structural Glass Systems, Inc. (“SGS”). Due to the pending impact of these responses, Staff is requesting a 45-day extension of time, which will grant the parties time to submit responses to the DRs and afford Staff the necessary time to perform

its analysis of the facts in preparation of Staff's report. Staff requests the Commission allow Staff to file its report in this matter on or before January 30, 2023.

4. Staff notified Spire and SGS of its intent to request a 45-day extension and both parties responded by stating that they have no objection to Staff's request.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order granting Staff's request to file its recommendation on or before January 30, 2023, and grant such other and further relief as the Commission finds reasonable under the circumstances.
