- JUDGE STEARLEY: Good morning, today is
- 3 Tuesday, February 5th, 2008. We are here for a
- 4 scheduled pre-hearing conference in Percy Cannon
- 5 versus Missouri Gas Energy, Case No. GC-2008-0169.
- 6 My name is Harold Stearley, I'm the presiding
- 7 officer over this matter. And we will begin by taking
- 8 oral entries of appearance beginning with MGE.
- 9 MR. COOPER: Dean L. Cooper, law firm of
- 10 Brydon, Swearengen & England, P.C., P.O. Box 456,
- 11 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 appearing on behalf of
- 12 Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union
- 13 Company.
- 14 JUDGE STEARLEY: On behalf of the Missouri
- 15 Public Service Commission.
- MR. THOMPSON: Yes, Judge, thank you.
- 17 Kevin Thompson, General Counsel, P.O. Box 360,
- 18 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, appearing on behalf of
- 19 the staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission.
- 20 JUDGE STEARLEY: I'm going to let the
- 21 record reflect that no one is present for the Office
- 22 of Public Counsel and that we have made numerous
- 23 attempts this morning to have the Complainant join us
- 24 by phone bridge, Mr. Percy Cannon, and have been
- 25 unable to make contact with Mr. Cannon this morning,

- 1 so he also is not in appearance.
- 2 The reason I scheduled this pre-hearing conference

- 3 in this; MGE had filed the Notice of Satisfaction in
- 4 this case back on December 21st and gave Mr. Cannon an
- 5 opportunity to respond to that, and he did not, so I
- 6 actually initiated a contact with him, procedurally,
- 7 to make sure he understood that he was, in fact,
- 8 supposed to respond and asked him the reason for his
- 9 not filing a response with the Commission, and at that
- 10 point Mr. Cannon expressed his confusion with regard
- 11 to what the Notice of Satisfaction actually meant.
- 12 So, the Commission, kind of keeping in its policy
- of providing pro se complainants an abundance of
- 14 process, set up this pre-hearing conference today to
- 15 be sure Mr. Cannon understood the implications of the
- 16 Notice of Satisfaction and if there were any other
- 17 issues not addressed in his complaint that he would
- 18 have the opportunity to converse with the other
- 19 parties in private regarding those matters and perhaps
- 20 reach settlement.
- 21 Since he has not shown, I assume MGE would like to
- 22 go forward with having this case dismissed?
- MR. COOPER: We would, Your Honor, yes.
- MR. THOMPSON: Staff has no objection.
- 25 It's our understanding Mr. Cannon is receiving gas

- 1 service, that he is making payments on amounts owed
- 2 pursuant to a satisfactory payment plan, and that, in
- 3 fact, there is nothing remaining to be redressed or to
- 4 be done in this case.
- 5 JUDGE STEARLEY: And if I understand the
- 6 Notice of Satisfaction correctly, the other portion of
- 7 Mr. Cannon's complaint of bills following him from two
- 8 proceeding addresses has also been resolved?
- 9 MR. COOPER: That's correct, Your Honor.
- 10 MGE has indicated that it will disassociate those
- 11 debts at those two addresses from Mr. Cannon such that
- 12 should he seek service in his name in the future there
- 13 would not be any attempt to recover those amounts from
- 14 Mr. Cannon.
- JUDGE STEARLEY: Well, very well. It
- 16 appears the two items that were the subject of Mr.
- 17 Cannon's complaint have been, in fact, resolved, and
- 18 we certainly have given Mr. Cannon ample opportunity
- 19 to respond if there were any other issues open at this
- 20 time.
- 21 Staff and MGE appear to be in agreement, Office of
- 22 Public Counsel did not appear, so at this point in
- 23 time I will prepare an order to take to the
- 24 Commissioners at the earliest possible agenda meeting.
- With that we will adjourn this pre-hearing
