On June 25, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. applied for a depreciation authority order establishing a new annual depreciation rate for smart meter devices.

On June 29, 2020, Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed an application to intervene. MECG's application contends its interests are different from the general public. MECG contends allowing MECG to intervene will serve the public interest by assisting the record for the Commission's decision in this case.
