Page 4 1 The following proceedings began at 2:10 p.m.: 2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Let's go ahead and go on the 3 record at this point and we'll make a record of what's 4 qoing on. We're here today for a procedural conference 5 in File Number GO-2022-0327, and the procedural 6 7 conference was scheduled to begin at two o'clock this 8 afternoon. We have representatives from Spire and from the Commission Staff here. We don't have a 9 10 representative from the Office of the Public Counsel 11 yet. 12 But rather than make everybody wait, we'll go 13 ahead and make a record on this proceeding and begin 14 with taking entries of appearance for Spire? 15 MR. ARIAS: Good afternoon, Your Honor. Antonio Arias on behalf of Spire Missouri, Inc. With me 16 17 today is Mr. Scott Weitzel just on the phone. JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for Staff? 18 19 MS. MYERS: Good afternoon, Judge. Jamie 20 Myers on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public 21 Service Commission. I have with me Ethan Dwyer, who is 2.2 our legal intern, and then Staff members Kim Bolin, 23 Karen Lyons and Lisa Ferguson. 24 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Thank you. And 25 is there anyone on the line for Public Counsel? I don't

Page 5 1 The other party in the case is MECG, and I see anyone. 2 don't see anyone here from them either. 3 I called this procedural conference in hopes that the parties could get together and try and discuss 4 5 a possible resolution of this case, which was, in fact, suggested by Public Counsel when they responded to the 6 7 filing made by Spire about a month ago. And obviously 8 with Public Counsel not being present, that's not going 9 to happen today, but I will encourage you to go ahead 10 and discuss this with Public Counsel when you are able 11 to do so. 12 At some point we'll need to set up a procedural schedule to resolve any disputes that cannot 13 So I'll ask that the parties or I'll order 14 be resolved. 15 the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule. 16 MR. ARIAS: Your Honor, I apologize. If I may 17 before you continue through this just -- Spire Missouri 18 was in Jeff City, Jefferson City, last week on Thursday 19 to attend a technical conference in relation to the rate 20 At the end of this conference, we did talk with case. 21 Staff and Office of Public Counsel just briefly via the 2.2 attorneys just briefly about this case and where we kind 23 of saw it going. And one of the consensus, or at least general consensus at that point, was to kind of hold 24 25 this off for about 90 days and at that point if -- 90

Page 6 1 days to allow us to try to come to some sort of 2 resolution on this, whether that's a revision so that 3 CAM or any other possible resolution at that point and at 90 days then we file an update to the Court, whether 4 5 if we have come to a resolution to file that with the Court or to file for the need for a procedural schedule 6 7 at that point. 8 Spire is also open if at 90 days we still 9 can't come to a resolution but we think there's still 10 that responsibility, maybe just file a status update at 11 that point saying let's postpone this another 90 days. 12 So these are just things that -- possibilities. From the discussions on Thursday, the Office of the Public 13 Counsel seemed agreeable to this solution, and we can't 14 15 speak for them without them being here, but I just 16 wanted to put that out there. 17 JUDGE WOODRUFF: I appreciate that, and I see 18 that John Clizer has joined us. Mr. Clizer, are you 19 there? 20 MR. CLIZER: Judge Woodruff, I apologize for 21 being late. 22 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. If you want to go 23 ahead and enter an appearance. 24 MR. CLIZER: Yes. John Clizer on behalf of 25 the Missouri Office of the Public Counsel. I will

So 25 I'm okay with that. Wanted to throw that out to the

Depending on what you tell me, we may need to 5 set a procedural schedule or push it back further as 6 needed. 7 MR. CLIZER: I have no problem with that date. 8 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Then I will go ahead 9 and issue a written order in the case also memorializing 10 that agreement. I think that's all I had to talk about 11 today with that understanding. Is there anything 12 anybody else wants to bring up while we're on the record? Okay. I hear nothing, so at this point then we 13 14 are adjourned and I'll wait to hear from you on the 24th 15 of October. MR. ARIAS: Thank you for making this a WebEx 16 17 hearing for us today.
