



shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Laclede's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing that service area.

The Commission notes that the tariff implementing the ISRS rates Laclede requests would become effective on February 11. Because the Commission likely will not have a Staff Recommendation before that date, the Commission will suspend the tariff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis, and the County Commissions of the Counties of: St. Louis, St. Charles, Crawford, Jefferson, Franklin, Iron, Ste. Genevieve, St. Francois, Madison and Butler of the application.

2. The Information Officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall serve notice as set out in the body of this order.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than February 4, 2013. Such application shall be filed with:
