ORDER APPROVING CUSTOMER NOTICE

On December 6, 2013, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Laclede Gas Company (“MGE”) filed an application and petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo (Supp. 2012), and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 2.080 and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”). MGE filed sample customer notices for the Commission’s approval along with its application. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(9) requires the Commission to approve or reject those sample notices and allows the Office of the Public Counsel ten days to file a response.

On December 16, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission that the sample customer notices filed by MGE comply with the requirements of the Commission’s rule. Public Counsel did not file a response.

Based on its review of the sample notices and on Staff’s recommendation, the Commission finds that the sample notices submitted by MGE comply with the notice requirements established in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.265(8). The Commission will approve those notices.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The sample customer notices submitted by Missouri Gas Energy are approved.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
