**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO STAFF
RECOMMENDATION**

On December 6, 2013, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Laclede Gas Company (“MGE”) filed an application and petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (“ISRS”). The Commission’s Staff reviewed that application and on February 4, 2014, filed a recommendation. Staff advises the Commission to reject the ISRS tariff filed by MGE, but recommends that the Commission allow MGE to recover a revised amount through its ISRS. On February 5, MGE filed a notice indicating its agreement with Staff’s recommendation. MGE also asks the Commission to approve the company’s revised tariff to become effective on February 21.

Before acting on Staff’s recommendation, the Commission will give other parties an opportunity to respond or to request a hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Staff’s Recommendation in this matter shall do so no later than February 14, 2014.

2. Any party wishing to request a hearing regarding Missouri Gas Energy's Application and Petition to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge shall make such request no later than February 14, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
