## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR RESPONSE

Issue Date: June 15, 2011 Effective Date: June 15, 2011

On June 15, 2011, Atmos Energy Corporation filed a motion and accompanying tariff that would discontinue its Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factor for the Kirksville District. Atmos explains that the ACA balance for this district will be in an under-recovered state, by July 1. For that reason, Atmos asks the Commission to approve its tariff by July 1, to accomplish the elimination of the ACA factor for that district. Atmos also asks the Commission to waive any provisions of Atmos' tariff that would preclude the filing of the tariff revision.

If the Commission is to act on Atmos' motion and tariff at its June 29 agenda meeting, it will need to have a recommendation from its Staff by June 24. The Commission will also establish June 24 as the date for any other party to file a recommendation.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Atmos Energy Corporation's
  Motion for Waiver of Tariff Provisions and accompanying tariff no later than June 24, 2011.
- 2. Any other party wishing to respond to Atmos Energy Corporation's Motion for Waiver of Tariff Provisions and accompanying tariff shall do so no later than June 24, 2011.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
