## ORDER ESTABLISHING ACA BALANCES

Issue Date: February 10, 2016 Effective Date: February 20, 2016

On December 4, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation on the 2013-2014 Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") filing of Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities. Liberty Utilities originally filed its ACA for the 2013-2014 period on November 4, 2014. Staff's Procurement Analysis Unit reviewed Liberty Utilities' gas purchasing practices to evaluate the prudence of the company's purchasing decisions for the ACA period. Staff submitted recommendations regarding Liberty Utilities' Billed Revenue and Actual Gas Costs; Reliability Analysis and Gas Supply Planning; and, Hedging. Staff recommends the Commission direct Liberty Utilities to adjust the ACA account balance in its next filing.

Liberty Utilities filed a response to Staff's recommendation on January 21, 2016, in which it accepted the ACA balances recommended by Staff and generally accepted the other recommendations included in Staff's memorandum.<sup>2</sup> On January 29, Staff filed a

reply to Liberty Utilities' response indicating that it had concerns over the company's answers to items related to Reliability Analysis and Gas Supply Planning.<sup>3</sup> However, Staff states that the only action on which it requests the Commission issue an order is the adjustment to the ACA account balances.

After reviewing Staff's recommendations and Liberty Utilities' response, the Commission concludes that Staff's ending ACA balances should be accepted as a resolution of Liberty Utilities' 2013-2014 ACA audit. Because Staff's recommended balances are unopposed, the Commission will allow this order to go into effect in less than thirty days.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities shall adjust its ACA account balances in its next ACA filing to reflect the following Staff Balances for 2013-2014:
