## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On December 2, 2014, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("Summit") filed a *Motion to Consolidate*. Summit requested the Commission consolidate File Nos. GR-2015-0101 and GR-2015-0102. Both files involve the review of Summit's purchased gas adjustments. While the files concern two separate service territories, Summit states that gas purchases for both areas are centralized and have Summit as the responsible corporate entity.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3), the Commission may issue orders concerning pending cases to avoid unnecessary costs or delays if the actions involve related questions of law or fact. The above-captioned files both involve a review of Summit's gas purchasing practices. For both matters, the Commission set a December 18, 2015 deadline for the Commission's Staff to submit results and recommendations on Summit's actual cost adjustment filings.

The Commission set a December 15, 2014, deadline for responses to Summit's motion; no responses were received. Consolidation of the files will further judicial economy and avoid unnecessary costs or delay.

The Commission will grant Summit's motion.

- 1. File Nos. GR-2015-0101 and GR-2015-0102 are consolidated with File No. GR-2015-0101 being the lead matter.
