THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Jeremiah W. (Jay) Nixon, Attorney General, on behalf of the State of Missouri, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, respectfully requests that the Commission grant his application to intervene in the above-styled matter. This application is made for the following reasons:

- 1. On January 13, 2003, Southern Union Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) an application for authority to purchase the equity interests of Panhandle Eastern Pipeline Company, including its subsidiaries. The consummation of that transaction may have the effect of concentrating an unusually high percentage of the transport of natural gas in the western half of the State, and specifically to the greater Kansas City metropolitan area, within the control of Southern Union.
- 2. Among the powers vested with the Attorney General are those powers and duties set forth in Missouri's Antitrust Law, §§ 416.011 to 416.161, RSMo.
- 3. The Attorney General has a unique responsibility, aside from the Commission's or the Office of Public Counsel's, to prevent and restrain violations of Missouri's antitrust

statutes. Specifically, § 416.061.2 states in relevant part, "[i]t shall be the duty of the attorney general to enforce the provisions of section 416.011 to 416.161. It shall be the duty of the attorney general to institute civil proceedings to prevent and restrain violation of section 416.011 to 416.161."

- 4. The Attorney General is in the process of reviewing the proposed transaction, as is the Federal Trade Commission.
- 5. While the Attorney General's antitrust review pursuant to §§ 416.011 to 416.161 RSMo, is independent of whatever action the Commission takes pursuant to § 393.190 RSMo, because of the obvious overlap of relevant information, the Attorney General believes it would be beneficial to both his review and the Commission's if the Commission were to grant this intervention.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General respectfully requests that he be allowed to intervene in the above-styled matter.
