MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL DIRECT TESTIMONY

COMES NOW Applicant, Southern Union Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy ("Southern Union"), by and through counsel, pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.130(8) and requests leave to file supplemental direct testimony of David J. Kvapil in the captioned matter. In support thereof, Southern Union states that:

- On February 14, 2003, Southern Union caused to be filed the prepared Direct
 Testimony of David J. Kvapil in the captioned cause.
- 2. On the last page of Mr. Kvapil's testimony (page 13), he makes reference to the then-pending approval of the acquisition by Southern Union of all the equity interests of Panhandle Eastern Pipeline Company ("Panhandle Eastern") by the Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Energy (the "Department"). Mr. Kvapil testifies that approval by the Department is expected on February 19, 2003.
- 3. On February 19, 2003, the Department approved, among other things, Southern Union's Petition to acquire the equity interests of Panhandle Eastern, finding that the transaction is in the public interest.

- 4. Simultaneously herewith, Southern Union is filing additional direct testimony of Mr. Kvapil, the purpose of which is to supplement the prepared Direct Testimony filed by Mr. Kvapil on February 14, 2003. Mr. Kvapil's Supplemental Direct Testimony addresses the Department's action concerning Southern Union's Petition and offers as a schedule to his testimony a copy of the decision of the Department.
- 5. Permitting Mr. Kvapil to supplement his Direct Testimony will not prejudice any party to this proceeding all of whom have received a copy of the Department's decision in the on-going discovery process. Furthermore, Southern Union believes it is appropriate that the Commission be advised of this significant regulatory development in the State of Massachusetts, a matter of public record.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, Southern Union requests permission to supplement the pre-filed Direct Testimony of David J. Kvapil for the reasons aforesaid.
