**ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF
KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY AND KCP&L GREATER
MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY**

On January 14, 2013, Southern Union Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy, The Laclede Group, Inc., and Laclede Gas Company, filed an application asking the Commission to approve a sale in which Laclede Gas Company would acquire the entire franchise, works, and system of Southern Union’s Missouri Gas Energy operating division. The Commission provided notice of that filing and established February 13 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

On February 13, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) applied to intervene. KCP&L and GMO are electrical corporations and public utilities that provide regulated electric service in portions of western Missouri that overlap the service territory served by Missouri Gas Energy. More than ten days have passed since KCP&L and GMO applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that KCP&L and GMO's interest in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing KCP&L and GMO to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is granted.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
