ORDER GRANTING REQUESTED WAIVER

On October 15, 2007, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to waive a portion of the company's tariff. AmerenUE explains that in paragraph 6 of the stipulation and agreement that resolved Case No. GR-2007-0003, AmerenUE's recent natural gas rate case, AmerenUE agreed to include a provision in its tariffs that require the company to provide certain described documentation to Staff along with its annual ACA filing. AmerenUE's tariffs now contain the required provision.

AmerenUE's next annual ACA filing is due on October 18, 2007. Unfortunately, AmerenUE reports that it is not prepared to provide the required documentation to Staff along with its ACA filing. Instead, AmerenUE asks that it be allowed until December 1, to provide that documentation to Staff. The motion represents that AmerenUE has discussed this matter with Staff and that Staff does not object to AmerenUE's request. Because the filing date for the annual ACA filing is fast approaching, AmerenUE asks the Commission to act on its request for waiver no later than October 17.

The stipulation and agreement, as well as AmerenUE's tariff, requires AmerenUE to provide Staff with data useful in Staff's audit of the company's purchased gas costs. Since

Staff is willing to allow the company until December 1 to submit that information, the Commission will grant AmerenUE's request for more time.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Request for Waiver is granted.
2. No later than December 1, 2007, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE shall provide the Commission's Staff with the information required by its tariff and by paragraph 6 of the stipulation and agreement that resolved Case No. GR-2007-0003
3. This order shall become effective on October 17, 2007.
