On March 11, 2008,<sup>1</sup> Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation submitted tariffs designed to implement a general rate increase for steam service. On March 12, the Commission suspended the tariffs, directed various filings, set an intervention deadline, and set the matter for hearing.
