The Commission is granting the *Application to Intervene Out of Time* ("motion") filed by the City of Kansas City, Missouri ("City"). The City filed the motion on June 22, 2011. The City also alleges that the motion is filed beyond the deadline because of managerial delays between City personnel's knowledge of, and legal counsel's authorization to participate in, the action. The City alleges that its interest is different from the general public's interest because the City is a high-volume customer of the applicant. The Commission received no response to the motion within the time set by 4 CSR 240-2.080(15), so the Commission will grant the motion.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Application to Intervene Out of Time* is granted.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
