**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 22, 2008, Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule for this case. NE Rural explains that it has reached a settlement agreement with AT&T that is to be completed by November 4. Upon completion of the settlement, NE Rural will dismiss its complaint with prejudice. The procedural schedule requires NE Rural to file direct testimony on October 29. Since that testimony will be unnecessary when the case is dismissed, NE Rural asks the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule.

The Commission will grant NE Rural's motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule for this case, including Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company's obligation to file direct testimony on October 29, 2008, is suspended until further order of the Commission.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
