# ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING FILING

Issue Date: June 8, 2018 Effective Date: June 8, 2018

On June 7, 2018, Spire Missouri Inc., filed applications and petitions with the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Sections 393.1009, 393.1012, and 393.1015, RSMo. 2016, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 3.265, requesting that the Commission authorize it to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge ("ISRS"). Section 393.1015.2(3), RSMo, requires that the Commission act on the applications no later than 120 days after the petition were filed; therefore, the Commission must issue an order regarding the applications effective no later than October 5, 2018.<sup>1</sup>

Section 393.1015.1(2), RSMo, requires that the Commission publish notice of the filing. Therefore, the Commission will give notice of this application to the general public and interested persons and set a date for intervention. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the county commission, or equivalent governmental body, of all of the counties within Spire's service area. The Data Center shall also mail a copy of this notice to the parties in Spire's most recent rate cases, File Nos. GR-2017-0215 and

GR-2017-0216. In addition, the Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Spire's service area, and to the members of the General Assembly representing Spire's service area.

Section 393.1015.2(2), RSMo, allows the Commission's Staff to examine Spire's application to change its ISRS and allows Staff to submit a report of its examination no later than sixty days after the petition is filed. Consequently, the Commission will establish a deadline for Staff to file a recommendation regarding the application.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve notice as set out in the body of this order.
- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall serve notice as set out in the body of this order.
- 3. Any entity wishing to intervene in these matters shall file an application to do so no later than June 18, 2018.
- 4. No later than August 6, 2018, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation in these matters.
  - 5. This order shall be effective when issued.
