The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Application to Intervene by the Missouri Propane Gas Association* ("motion").<sup>1</sup> The Missouri Propane Gas Association filed the motion on January 21, 2014. The Commission received no response to the motion within the time prescribed by regulation.<sup>2</sup> The motion alleges facts supporting the intervention on a timely motion.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The *Application to Intervene by the Missouri Propane Gas Association* is granted.
