### **RESPONSE AND REQUEST FOR MEDIATION**

COMES NOW, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company"), pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.125(2)(A) and for its *Response and Request for Mediation* states as follows.

#### Procedural Background

- 1. On March 12, 2021, John W. Williamson ("Complainant") filed a small formal complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Ameren Missouri.
- 2. On March 17, 2021, the Commission issued its Notice of Small Formal Complaint and Order Directing Staff to Investigate and File a Report which *inter alia* directed Ameren Missouri to file a Response to the Complaint no later than Friday, April 16, 2021.

#### Request for Mediation

- 3. 20 CSR 4240-2.125 is entitled "Procedures for Alternative Dispute Resolution." Per 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(A), the utility against whom the small formal complaint has been filed is allowed thirty (30) days after the date of notice to "satisfy the complaint or file an answer."
- 4. 20 CSR 4240-2.125(2)(A) states the Commission "may order mediation before any further proceeding in a case."
- 5. 20 CSR 4240-2.125(2)(B) states when the Commission "deems it appropriate *or upon request for mediation* (Emphasis Supplied), the Commission may appoint a presiding officer or other neutral third party other than the presiding officer assigned to the case to mediate the dispute."

- 6. 20 CSR 4240-2.125(2)(C) dictates that once a request for mediation has been requested, "[a]ll other actions on the case shall cease and all time limitations, shall be tolled pending the completion of mediation process, except as otherwise provided by law."
- 7. The parties have discussed the efficacy of mediation and desire that it be ordered by the Commission.

**WHEREFORE**, Ameren Missouri, with Complainant's consent, respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order authorizing the parties to engage in mediation.
