ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On October 16¹, Yvonne Ferguson filed a complaint against Missouri Gas Energy. The Commission ordered its Staff to investigate her complaint and to file a report no later than November 25.

On November 6, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff states that due to the press of business, it needs until December 12 to complete the report. Staff further states that it has contacted MGE and Ms. Ferguson, and that they do not object to Staff's request.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. However, because Staff indicates that MGE and Ms. Ferguson do not object to Staff's motion, the Commission will dispense with the rule, and will take up Staff's motion unopposed.


The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.
