ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On April 28, 2010, the Commission granted the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 1439, AFL-CIO's ("Local 1439") late application to intervene. On May 6, 2010, Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos") filed a motion for reconsideration asserting the Commission's order was unlawful, unjust and unreasonable. Atmos claims the order is inconsistent with prior Commission orders, the Commission's rules and Section 386.315.

The Commission's findings and decision are clearly delineated in its April 28, 2010 order. The Commission will deny Atmos' motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Atmos Energy Corporation's Motion for Reconsideration of its order granting the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 1439, AFL-CIO late intervention is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
