**ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO
REMAINING APPLICANTS**

On December 21, 2012, Laclede Gas Company filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a request to increase its annual revenues. The Commission issued notice of the request and set January 14, 2013, as the date by which any applications to intervene must be filed.

On January 14, Wal-Mart Stores East, L.P and Sam’s East, Inc, the American Association of Retired Persons, the Consumers Council of Missouri, and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers filed applications to intervene. On January 15, with good cause, St. Charles County filed its application to intervene. Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080 (13) parties are allowed 10 days to respond to pleadings. No party has responded to any of these applications to intervene and more than 10 days have expired. The Commission will therefore grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Wal-Mart Stores East, L.P. and Sam’s East, Inc.’s application to intervene is granted.

2. The American Association of Retired Persons’ application to intervene is granted.

3. The Consumers Council of Missouri's application to intervene is granted.
4. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' application to intervene is granted.
5. St. Charles County's application to intervene is granted.
6. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
