On August 15, 2008,¹ Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation ("Trigen") sought clarification from the Commission regarding the form of the notice it had prepared to send to its customers in relation to its proposed rate increase. Trigen had submitted a draft notice to the Commission on April 24. No party has objected to the proposed notice. The Commission approves the draft notice with a modification to reflect the change in the evidentiary hearing schedule that was ordered on June 24. The Commission will also direct Trigen to provide each of its customers a copy of the notice no later than September 1, 2008.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation's proposed customer notice, appearing as Appendix B to the "Jointly Proposed Procedural Schedule and Recommendations Regarding Test Year, True-Up and Local Public Hearings," filed on April 24, 2008 is hereby adopted with a modification to reflect the currently scheduled hearing dates of October 20-24 and October 27-29, 2008.

¹ All dates throughout this order refer to the year 2008 unless otherwise noted.

2. Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation is directed to issue a copy of this notice to all of its customers no later than September 1, 2008.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issue.
