On July 15, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a steam service tariff sheet providing the current Quarterly Cost Adjustment for service provided to steam customers in the company's St. Joseph, Missouri, and environs service territory. The tariff sheet bears an effective date of September 1, 2009.

The Commission finds that notice of the tariff filing shall be given to the parties to KCPL/GMO's most recent steam rate case. The Commission will also set dates for the filing of applications to intervene, the Commission Staff's recommendation, and for any responses to Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on all parties to Case No. HR-2005-0450, the most recent steam rate case of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (formerly known as Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks-L&P).

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation concerning the tariff sheet filed by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, designated Tariff File No. JH-2010-0026, no later than August 7, 2009.

5. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
