ORDER FILING SETTLEMENT TARIFF AS COMPLIANCE TARIFF

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting *Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc.’s Motion for Acceptance of Settlement Tariffs as Compliance Tariffs* (“motion”).

Veolia Energy Kansas City, Inc., (“Veolia”) filed the motion on October 12, 2011, citing the Commission’s decision.¹ In that decision, the Commission approved the *Stipulation and Agreement* and directed Veolia to “file a new tariff (“compliance tariff”) consistent with the *Stipulation and Agreement*.”² The *Stipulation and Agreement* included illustrative tariff sheets as Appendix A (“settlement tariff”).

In the motion, Veolia asks the Commission to deem the settlement tariff filed as the compliance tariff without the filing of hard copy. Such procedure will promote efficiency and simplify the record. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. All tariff sheets in Appendix A of the *Stipulation and Agreement* are filed in compliance with the *Order Approving and Incorporating Stipulation and Agreement, Rejecting Tariffs, and Directing Filing of New Tariffs*, page 9, paragraph 5.

2. Such tariff sheets already on file, in the Commission's electronic filing and information system, shall suffice for that purpose without the filing of hard copy.
