**ORDER APPROVING WAIVER AND TARIFF**

Effective Date: November 16, 2007

On November 5, 2007, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE or Company), a division of Southern Union Company, of Kansas City, Missouri, filed an *Application for Waiver Concerning PGA Tariff Filing and Motion for Expedited Treatment* (Waiver). MGE seeks a waiver of the provision that prohibits the company from making more than one PGA filing in two consecutive calendar months to correct an error and to add a rate for the large volume transportation (LVT) customers.

The rate was erroneously dropped from MGE's recent winter PGA filing, showing the rate at \$0.000 per one-hundred cubic feet (Ccf). MGE requests that the proposed tariff sheet become effective November 15, 2007. The LVT PGA rate should have been \$0.12067 per Ccf.

The Commission's Staff filed its Memorandum and Recommendation on November 9, 2007. In its Memorandum and Recommendation, Staff does not object to MGE's request for Waiver from its PGA Clause to make this PGA filing to correct the error. Nor does staff object to MGE's request for expedited treatment to allow the

proposed tariff sheet, reflecting the correction, to become effective on November 15, 2007. Staff notes that, because MGE's PGA clause allows for PGA change filings to take effect on ten days' notice, good cause has been shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, to permit the tariffs to become effective on less than 30 days' notice. Staff recommends that the rates be immediately approved on an interim basis, subject to refund.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's Memorandum and Recommendation. After considering Staff's recommendation, and for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, the Commission concludes that the waiver to the Company's Commission-approved PGA and the proposed tariff sheet shall be approved to become effective on November 16, 2007, on an interim basis, subject to refund.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The proposed tariff sheet filed on November 5, 2007, by Missouri Gas Energy is approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, for service rendered on and after November 16, 2007. The specific tariff sheet approved is:
