On October 11, 2013, the Missouri Supreme Court issued its mandate in *Office of the Public Counsel v. Missouri Public Service Commission and Atmos Energy Corporation*, No. SC92964, reversing the Commission's report and order and remanding this matter to the Commission for further proceedings in conformity with the opinion of the Court.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. Parties wishing to appear by telephone will be provided with a telephone conference number. At the conference, parties should be prepared to discuss the appropriate procedures for resolution of the case, including whether it is necessary to engage in additional discovery and a supplemental evidentiary hearing. If the parties propose a supplemental hearing, the parties should be prepared to discuss the elements of a joint procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on November 13, 2013, beginning at 2:00 p.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required
