ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT AND COUNTERCLAIMS WITH PREJUDICE

On August 14, 2013, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement that resolved both Staff's complaint against Laclede Gas Company and Laclede's counterclaim against Staff. That stipulation and agreement provided that upon the Commission's approval of the stipulation and agreement, both Staff's complaint and Laclede's counterclaim would be dismissed with prejudice. The Commission's order approving the stipulation and agreement became effective on August 24, and on August 26 Staff and Laclede jointly filed a motion asking the Commission to dismiss the complaint and counterclaims with prejudice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides that after prepared testimony has been filed, as was done in this case, a complainant may voluntarily dismiss a complaint by leave of the Commission. Since the issues presented in this complaint have been resolved by the approved stipulation and agreement, the Commission will grant leave for the parties to dismiss their complaint and counterclaims.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Joint Motion to Dismiss Complaint and Counterclaims with Prejudice is granted and the complaint and counterclaims are dismissed with prejudice.
