- 1. On April 4, 2007, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE) filed tariffs to correct an oversight by MGE to correct a rate that was approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. GR-2006-0422. The nature of the oversight was a mathematical error. The correction is reflected in MGE's April, 4, 2007 filing.
- 2. Staff has reviewed the tariffs, and in its Memorandum attached as Appendix A, recommends that the Commission approve the substitute tariffs as in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order dated March 22, 2007.
- 3. Staff also recommends that the tariffs become effective for service on and after May 4, 2007.

WHEREFORE Staff recommends that the Commission approve MGE's substitute tariff sheets become effective for service on and after May 4, 2007.
