Dear Mr. Hubbs:

On May 19, 1987, the Commission entered its Order in the above-referenced cases approving the Stipulation and Agreement executed by ALLTEL Missouri, Inc., the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the Office of Public Counsel. As a result of the Commission's adoption of the Stipulation and Agreement, ALLTEL was directed to implement revised intrastate tariffs reducing its Missouri jurisdictional gross annual revenues by \$800,000, exclusive of license, occupation, franchise, sales, gross receipts or other similar fees or taxes. By reason of Paragraph 1 of the Stipulation and Agreement, ALLTEL was authorized to implement revised intrastate tariffs effective June 1, 1987.

In response to the Commission's May 19, 1987 Order, ALLTEL prepared and filed revised intrastate tariffs decreasing its intrastate revenues by \$800,000. These tariffs were filed with the Commission on May 21, 1987. On May 27, 1987, the Commission entered an Order approving ALLTEL's revised intrastate tariffs. The Commission ordered that these revised tariffs be effective on June 1, 1987.

This letter will advise the Commission and the other parties to the above-referenced cases that, due to computer programming problems, ALLTEL was unable to implement the

revised intrastate tariffs reducing local exchange service rates prior to the June 8th billing cycle. As a result, the June 1987 bills submitted to customers in ALLTEL'S Verona, Wheaton, Fairdealing, Grandin, Greenville, Naylor, Oxly and Patterson exchanges did not reflect the reductions in local exchange service rates authorized in the Commission's May 19 and 27, 1987 Orders. The June 1987 bills submitted to all other Missouri customers will reflect the decreases authorized by the Commission.

Since ALLTEL was unable to implement the decreased local exchange service rates authorized by the Commission before the billing of customers in the foregoing exchanges was completed, each customer in the foregoing exchanges will receive a credit on his or her July 1987 bill equal to the reduction in local exchange service rates authorized by the Commission in its May 19 and May 27, 1987 Orders. Further, by the end of June 1987, the lower local exchange service rates authorized by the Commission will be implemented for all Missouri customers.

I request that you bring this information to the Commission's attention.
