
**RESPONSE OF SEDALIA INDUSTRIAL ENERGY USERS' ASSOCIATION

Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association (SIEUA) and the Federal Executive Agencies (FEA) do not oppose Public Counsel's request that public hearings be ordered in this case. Given the juxtaposition of this technical class cost-of-service case with the pending more traditional rate case, we would suggest that careful wording of any notice of such hearings is critical to avoid public confusion and misunderstanding about the relationship between the two cases.


