## STAFF REPLY TO SUMMIT'S RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and states for its Reply as follows:

- 1. On August 26, 2013, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing* directing Staff to file a reply no later than September 5, 2013, to the *Response to Staff Recommendation and Memorandum* (Response) that Summit Natural Gas of Missouri (Summit) filed on August 26, 2013.
- 2. Staff has reviewed Summit's Response and is of the opinion there are no issues in this case that require either a procedural schedule or resolution by the Commission.
- 3. However, the Staff offers the following reply to Summit's comments on the matter of its selection of heating degree days (HDD) for its Northern and Southern systems. The Staff informed Summit on August 9, 2013, after it had filed its Recommendation, that it did not dispute Summit's selection of HDD for the Northern system and that it would review Summit's selection of weather station and peak HDD in the relevant Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) review for the Southern system. That said, Staff did not recommend financial adjustments related to the HDD issue and is of the belief this issue is resolved for the 2011/2012 ACA period. Staff appreciates the dialog with Summit on the HDD issue.

4. Based on Summit's Response, the Staff believes there is agreement with the 2011/2012 ACA balances listed in the tables contained in Staff's July 24, 2013, Recommendation as shown below:
