ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

Issue Date: November 17, 2016

Effective Date: December 9, 2016

The signatories to the *Partial Stipulation and Agreement as to Energy Efficiency, Weatherization, and Other Matters*¹ (“stipulation”) filed a *Joint Motion for Approval of Tariff Sheets*² (“motion”). The motion seeks approval of tariff sheets (“tariff”)³ filed in compliance with the Commission’s order⁴ incorporating, and ordering compliance with, the stipulation (“order incorporating the stipulation”). Staff filed its recommendation in favor of approving the compliance tariff and the Commission received no other response within the time set by order.⁵ No evidentiary hearing is necessary to grant unopposed relief.⁶ The Commission concludes that the tariff complies with the order incorporating the stipulation and will approve the tariff.
