ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL ORDERS AND CANCELLING HEARINGS

On March 31, April 7, and April 14, 2020, ¹ the Commission issued a procedural schedule, supplemental procedural order, and second supplemental procedural order. The cases were set for an evidentiary hearing on April 27 and 28. Because the Commission determined that with COVID 19 issues, this hearing should be conducted by Zoom, on April 14 the Commission ordered an April 21 pretrial conference to test and address Zoom issues. On April 16, the parties filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and a Joint Motion to Suspend Procedural Order. The parties state that all issues in the cases have been resolved and ask that the procedural schedule be suspended pending Commission approval of their agreement. The Commission will suspend the March 31, April 7, and April 14 procedural orders and will cancel the hearings scheduled for April 21, 27, and 28.
