## ORDER REQUIRING FILING

On February 3, 2020,¹ Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire Missouri), on behalf of its operating units, Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West, filed a request for waiver of the 60-day notice provisions of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1)² and tendered a Verified Application and Petition of Spire Missouri, Inc. to Change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West. On February 13, Spire Missouri filed a Corrected – Verified Application and Petition of Spire Missouri Inc. to Change Its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for Its Spire Missouri West [and East] Territory. On February 14, the deadline for responses, the Commission Staff filed a response stating it had no objection to the requested waiver. No other party responded. On February 18, the Commission issued

its Order Directing Notice, Setting Intervention Deadline, Directing Filing and Suspending Tariff Sheets.

Although the parties' recommendations are not due per the February 18 order until April 3, because of the coronavirus and logistical problems it may create for arranging for an evidentiary hearing, the Commission will go ahead now and order the parties to confer together and file a proposed procedural schedule.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than March 26, 2020, the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule setting out proposed date(s) for an evidentiary hearing; deadlines for all filings, including testimony, exhibits, issues statements, position statements, and briefs; and addressing all other procedural concerns as deemed necessary by the parties.
  - 2. All prior Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
  - 3. This Order shall be effective when issued.
