ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Spire Missouri, Inc. filed a draft allocation manual on May 24, 2022. On June 14, 2022, the Midwest Energy Consumer's Group (MECG) filed a timely application to intervene. More than ten days have passed since MECG applied to intervene and no one has responded to that application.¹

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing MECG to participate will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MECG's application to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
