**FIRST REVISION TO  
APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY  
AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION**

800 Response Information Services LLC (“Applicant” or “Company”), a Vermont limited liability company, hereby seeks to revise paragraph 8 of its Application for a Certificate of Service Authority and for Competitive Classification, which application was filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) on December 29, 2010. Specifically, the Applicant, consistent with the Commission’s treatment of other certificated telecommunications companies, Applicant respectfully requests that, pursuant to sections 392.361 and 392.420 RSMo, the following revised list of statutes and regulations be waived with respect to its interexchange service offerings:

Statutory Provisions

- 392.210.2 -- uniform system of accounts
- 392.240.1 -- ratemaking
- 392.270 -- valuation of property (ratemaking)
- 392.280 -- depreciation accounts
- 392.290 -- issuance of securities
- 392.300 -- transfer of property and ownership of stock
- 392.310 -- stock & debt issuance
- 392.320 -- stock dividend payment
- 392.330 -- issuance of securities, debts and notes
- 392.340 -- reorganizations

Commission Rules

- 4 CSR 240-3.550 (4), (5)(A) -- held order records, quality of service reports
- 4 CSR 240-10.020 -- depreciation fund income
- 4 CSR 240-30.040 -- Uniform System of Accounts
- 4 CSR 240-32.050 (4)(B) -- provide "white page" telephone directories in the St. Louis and Kansas City metropolitan areas.  
As a competitive local exchange carrier operating in the St. Louis and Kansas City metropolitan areas, the Company is given a partial exemption from 4 CSR 240-32.050 (4)(B), in that, when AT&T does not automatically deliver a directory to the Company's subscribers, the Company may discharge its obligation to distribute such directories by instructing its end-user customers to (a) contact the Company for a copy of the directory (who will in turn forward the request to AT&T); or, alternatively, (b) contact AT&T directly for a copy of the directory.

WHEREFORE, 800 Response Information Services LLC respectfully requests that the Commission accept the above stated revision to paragraph 8 of its Application and: (1) grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri; (2) grant Applicant and its proposed services competitive status; (3) waive the application of the above-referenced statutes and Commission rules; and (4) approve its tariffs upon submission.



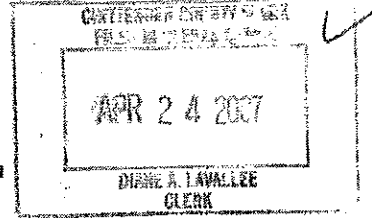
