STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER CONCERNING MOTION TO MODIFY AND MGE'S RESPONSEBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri ("Staff") and for its response to the Commission's Order Concerning Motion to Modify of December 2, 1994 and the subsequent response of Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE"), a division of Southern Union Company ("Southern Union") respectfully states as follows:

1. The Staff first wishes to assure the Commission that there has been no "abandonment" of the prioritization schedule for replacement of cast iron and unprotected steel mains by MGE. The Staff, in its recommendation, agreed to the reprioritization of categories proposed by MGE based on MGE's experience in the actual replacement of mains since the inception of the original plan. The Staff's agreement with this reprioritization of categories was based on its monitoring of both Western Resources, Inc. d/b/a Gas Service's replacement program and MGE's continued work on that program over the years of its operation. In addition, the Staff participated in detailed meetings with MGE's technical staff regarding their reasons for changing the categories and proposed ideas for those changes.

- 2. This monitoring and those detailed discussions did not easily lend themselves to condensation into a brief memorandum format. This, coupled with the Staff's desire to meet MGE's request expediently, produced a recommendation which lacked the level of detail desired by the Commission.
- 3. The Staff has reviewed a draft of MGE's response to the December 2 order and concurs in MGE's averments. The Staff is willing and ready to participate in an on the record conference to answer the Commission's questions or to submit whatever additional documentation the Commission may deem appropriate.
