ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On May 1, 2013, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order effective May 15, 2013, regarding Southern Union Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy's application for approval to change its infrastructure system replacement surcharge. On May 9, 2013, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the order. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
