**RECONCILIATION UPDATE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully states as follows:

1. At the time Staff originally calculated the value of the contested issues in this case and prepared its reconciliation, Staff based its calculation of the value of the telemetry equipment issue on the two work orders referenced in the direct testimony of the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) witness Jacqueline Moore rather than the somewhat higher figure of \$401,259, because Staff did not realize that OPC was contesting any additional amount for telemetry equipment beyond what was included in the two work orders.<sup>1</sup> If the value of the issue is calculated based on the \$401,259 figure, the revenue requirement value of the telemetry issue for purposes of the reconciliation would be \$41,128 rather than \$33,486<sup>2</sup> -- a difference of \$7,642.<sup>3</sup>

**WHEREFORE,** Staff respectfully requests the Commission accept this Reconciliation Update.
