ORDER OPENING NEW PGA/ACA FILE

On May 15, 2009, the Commission's Staff filed a pleading in File No. GR-2008-0364 asking the Commission to open a new purchased gas adjustment/actual cost adjustment case to handle Atmos Energy Corporations' PGA/ACA for 2008-2009. Staff further explained that filings made in February and April 2009 in GR-2008-0364, Atmos' 2007-2008 PGA/ACA case, should have been made in a new case because they reflect changes made in the new ACA period. Staff asks the Commission to move the February and April 2009 pleadings from GR-2008-0364 into this new case.

Staff explains that the requested transfer of documents is procedural only and will have no effect on Staff's review of these cases. Staff represents that neither Atmos nor Public Counsel object to its request.

The Commission has opened the new case requested by Staff. However, removing the February and April 2009 filings from GR-2008-0364 and placing them in the new file would create a gap in the Commission's official records and could create

confusion in the future. Therefore, the Commission will direct its data center to duplicate those entries and add them to GR-2009-0417

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall duplicate entry numbers 13-21 from the docket sheet for File No. GR-2008-0364 and place the duplicate entries in the docket sheet for File No. GR-2009-0417.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
