**ORDER APPROVING REVISED ACA FACTOR AND GRANTING
WAIVER OF TARIFF PROVISIONS**

Issue Date: June 29, 2011

Effective Date: July 1, 2011

On June 15, 2011, Atmos Energy Corporation filed a motion and accompanying tariff that would discontinue the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factor for the Kirksville Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) rate district. That tariff carries a July 1 effective date. Atmos states that the ACA balance for the Kirksville district will be near zero by July 1, 2011. The effect of the change will increase the Total PGA factor for the Kirksville Area from \$0.56770 to \$0.63580 for its firm sales customers.

The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding Atmos' motion and tariff by June 24. The Commission also ordered any other party wishing to respond to Atmos' filing to do so by the same time. Staff filed its recommendation on June 23. No other party responded.

Staff confirms Atmos' representations regarding its ACA balances and advises the Commission to grant Atmos' motion and approve the submitted tariff.

The Commission finds that Atmos' tariff and motion are reasonable, and are not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant the requested waiver and will approve the submitted tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed tariff submitted under Tariff No. YG-2011-0634, by Atmos Energy Corporation, is approved, effective on and after July 1, 2011. The specific tariff sheet approved is:

2. Atmos Energy Corporation is granted a waiver from any provision of its tariff that would preclude the filing of the tariff approved in the previous paragraph.

3. This order shall become effective July 1, 2011.
