ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CLOSE CASE AND ESTABLISHING ACA BALANCE

Issue Date: October 3, 2013 Effective Date: October 13, 2013

On October 18, 2011, Missouri Gas Energy filed its Actual Cost Adjustment for the period of July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. The Staff of the Commission reviewed the filing and on November 30, 2012, filed its Recommendation.

Staff recommended that the company: (1) because of an adjustment error, decrease its ACA balance by \$239,162.11; (2) establish certain account balances; (3) respond to Staff's concerns and recommendations regarding reliability analysis, gas supply planning and hedging.

The account balances established by Staff, as shown in its Memorandum, are:

In January of 2013, the company informed the Commission that it agreed with Staff's adjustments and recommendations, had taken steps consistent with Staff's recommendations and that there were no issues to be resolved by the Commission.

Staff then filed a motion to close the case and requested that the Commission establish the ACA balances set out the recommendation. Staff states that no party objects to the motion.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and will grant the requested relief.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The June 30, 2011, ACA balance as described in the Staff of the Commission's Memorandum, and set out in the body of this order, is established.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on October 13, 2013.
 - 3. This file shall be closed on October 14, 2013.
