On April 7, 2014, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) filed on behalf of the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel, a Notice of Settlement and Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule. MGE notified the Commission that the parties have reached a settlement in principle and intend to file an agreement by Friday, April 11, 2014. To facilitate this effort, MGE requests that the filing of certain pleadings due during the week of April 7 be deferred for one week and that the evidentiary hearings scheduled for the week of April 14 be cancelled. The company suggests that the hearing dates for the week of April 21, be preserved.

The Commission recognizes that the parties have reached a settlement in principle of all issues in the case and will grant the requested relief.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The filing of all pleadings due during the week of April 7, 2014, shall be deferred for one week.

2. Evidentiary hearings scheduled for the week of April 14, 2014, are cancelled.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
