ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR DISCOVERY

The Commission is granting *Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Discovery Motion* ("motion"). Staff filed the motion on June 27, 2014. The motion relates to Staff data request 0217 to Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("Summit"). Summit objected to that data request. So that Staff and Summit may resolve that dispute, instead of filing a discovery motion within the time set by order,¹ the motion seeks to extend the time for filing a discovery motion related to that objection. The Commission received no response to the motion within the time set by order.² Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. *Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Discovery Motion* is granted.
2. The time to file any discovery motion as described in the body of this order is extended until July 17, 2014
