**ORDER GRANTING STAFF MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION AND ORDER
GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

The Commission issued a Report and Order on December 3. That Report and Order required Liberty Utilities to file compliance tariffs by December 10, and also required Staff to file a Recommendation by December 11.

The Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Recommendation and Request for Expedited Treatment. Staff explains that December 11 is not enough time for Staff to review and respond to compliance tariffs. Staff asks the Commission to extend its time to respond to December 15, and for objections to be filed by December 16.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Request for Expedited Treatment is granted.
2. Staff's Recommendation shall be filed no later than December 15, 2014.
3. Any objections to the compliance tariffs or to Staff's Recommendation shall be filed no later than December 16, 2014.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
