On July 5, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed a Motion to Approve Tariff to Suspend Payment of Solar Rebates and Motion for Expedited Treatment. GMO asks the Commission to approve the tariff no later than September 3.


The Commission will order its Staff to file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a Status Report stating when it will file its Recommendation. The Commission will also give other parties an opportunity to respond to GMO’s motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or, in the alternative, a Status Report stating when it will file its Recommendation, no later than July 30, 2013.
2. Any other party wishing to respond shall do so no later than July 30, 2013.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
