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**APPLICATION**

TeleUno, Inc. ("TeleUno") or (Applicant), by its undersigned counsel, hereby submits its Application for Certificate of Authority to Provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services to resell intrastate telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, and for competitive classification. This filing is made pursuant to Sections 392.410, 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo and 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.510. Applicant respectfully requests the Commission issue an order that 1) grants Applicant a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 2) grants competitive status to Applicant pursuant to Section 392.361, RSMo, 3) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Sections 392.420 and 392.361, RSMo, and 4) approves Applicant's initial proposed interexchange tariff. In support of its application, Applicant states as follows:

2. TeleUno, Inc. is a corporation formed on June 6, 2000, in the state of Delaware. A copy of the Company's Certificate of Incorporation is attached as Exhibit A.

5. Applicant has been granted a Certificate of Authority to transact business as a foreign corporation in the state of Missouri. A copy of Applicant's Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State is attached as Exhibit B.

6. Applicant is a non facilities-based resale carrier of long distance intrastate, interstate and international telephone services for residential customers and thus requests competitive classification pursuant to Section 392.361 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-2.060(6)(A). Applicant will not provide operator services or service to pay telephones.

7. Applicant contracts for transmission services from its underlying carrier, Qwest Communications, at discounted rates based on a long-term volume commitment.

8. The Company proposes to resell intrastate telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.

9. Applicant is a telecommunications company which possesses the technical and managerial expertise to provide the services it proposes.

10. Applicant also possesses the necessary financial resources to provide the requested services.

11. In accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(6)(C), Applicant is simultaneously submitting its proposed tariff with a forty-five day effective date for approval by the Commission. The tariff contains the rules and regulations applicable to its customers, description of services offered and list of rates associated with such services. A copy of the tariff is attached hereto as Exhibit C. The Company requests that the Commission approve its MO P.S.C. Tariff No. 1 simultaneously with granting a certificate of service authority in this case.

12. Applicant will not unjustly discriminate among its customers as is prohibited under Section 392.200 RSMo.

13. Applicant has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involves customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

14. Applicant has no overdue annual reports or assessment fees.

15. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules, except those which are specifically waived by the Commission. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive interexchange telecommunications companies, TeleUno, Inc. requests that it be granted the following waivers of Missouri statutes and Commission rules:

Applicant submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this application because Applicant's proposed services will make discounted service available to customers whose traffic volume would not otherwise justify equivalent discounts. Approval of this Application will also benefit consumers in Missouri by creating greater competition in the interexchange marketplace, and by providing users with additional choices for billing and terminating their long distance calls and otherwise will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options, and offer service options consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, TeleUno, Inc. requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant it a Certificate of Authority to Provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services, authorizing it to provide resold intrastate telecommunications services to the public as proposed herein and set forth in the Company's Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 1; classify the Company and its proposed services as competitive; grant waivers of statutes and regulations as requested herein; and approve its separately submitted tariff.




