On August 2, 2006, Ag Processing Inc., a Cooperative (AGP), filed an application to intervene. AGP, an agricultural cooperative and large manufacturer and processor of soybean meal, soy-related food products, and other grain products, is an industrial steam customer of Aquila, Inc., in the St. Joseph service area. AGP was a party to Case No. HR-2005-0450, the steam rate case that resulted, *inter alia*, in the quarterly steam adjustment mechanism that is addressed in this case. AGP states that its interest in the current case is direct, immediate, and different from that of the general public, and cannot be adequately represented by any other party. For purposes of 4 CSR 240-2.075(2), AGP states that insofar as the change proposed by Aquila Networks-L&P in this filing is consistent with the negotiated and approved mechanism, AGP does not oppose Commission approval of the proposed change subject to the annual true-up process negotiated and referenced in Aquila's steam tariffs.

No party has objected to AGP's intervention, and the deadline for doing so has passed. The Commission finds that AGP meets the requirements for intervention and that its Application to Intervene shall be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Ag Processing Inc., a Cooperative, is

granted.

2. This order shall become effective on August 17, 2006.
